Re-imagine the world around you through the lens of art + design! Raleigh's Contemporary Art Museum invites you to explore the designed objects and environments that surround us, from the buildings above us to the shoes on our feet. Amidst installations by some of the nation's leading contemporary artists, you are encouraged to unleash your creativity through an action-packed week of fun and innovative projects.

The one-week summer studio merges conceptual development with hands-on explorations and emphasizes the importance of the design process from the initial idea to the final product. Through one-on-one instruction with local designers you will develop your unique voice and individual abilities to bring creative ideas to life by utilizing critical thinking techniques that artists, architects, and designers rely on to convey conceptual and real propositions. In the collaborative studio setting you will explore hand-drawing, printmaking, physical modeling, sculpture, collage, and many other forms of creative media. Ultimately you will discover the possibilities that art + design offers you to evaluate our surroundings, generate alternatives, and change the world according to your unique perspective!

Instructor: Sara Glee Queen

Sara Queen is currently a Teaching Fellow at the School of Architecture at North Carolina State University teaching a range of courses including History of Contemporary Architecture and an advanced seminar on Regional Infrastructure as well as graduate and undergraduate studios.

Sara recently graduated with distinction from the Graduate School of Design at Harvard University earning her Masters in Architecture. While pursuing her degree, Sara was a developer and principal instructor for Project Link, an introductory design studio for high school students. She received her Bachelor of Environmental Design in Architecture from North Carolina State University in 2002. She continues to pursue a design career at the intersection of art, exhibit design, and architecture.

FAQ

Who is eligible?

Rising seventh and eighth graders, at all experience levels.

What does it cost?

Registration for the studios are \$300. These fees cover the cost of instruction, project supplies and activities. A \$100 down payment is due with the completed application for either program and will be applied towards registration. Checks must be made out to "NC State University." We cannot accept credit card payments. Lunch is not included.

Do you offer financial assistance?

CAM Raleigh will consider requests for financial assistance based on demonstrated need. Parents/Guardian must submit a completed financial assistance request form and the student applicant must include a letter stating their goals and artistic interests. Financial assistance request forms will be available online on March 15, 2011.

How do I apply?

Application forms will be available to download from our website on **March 15, 2011**. Camp slots are filled on a first-come first-served basis (based on postmark date). We expect these studios to fill up VERY quickly so please apply early! Applications MUST be mailed; hand-delivered forms cannot be accepted.

Where does it happen?

Summer Studios will take place at CAM Raleigh (Contemporary Art Museum) in downtown Raleigh, located at 409 West Martin Street.

Who teaches the studios?

Summer Studios are taught by professional designers with substantial teaching experience. Each instructor is joined by a studio assistant who is a current NC State College of Design student or a recent graduate.

How many students are in each studio?

Each studio will have a max of 20 students.

Does CAM Raleigh provide lunch?

Lunch is not provided. Students must bring their own lunch.

What is the schedule for the Summer Studios?

Students must arrive at CAM Raleigh between 8:30-8:45 a.m. Studio instruction will start promptly at 9:00 a.m. All students must be picked up between 5:00-5:30 p.m. A full schedule will be emailed to registered participants two weeks prior to the start of their studio.

Can I register for both sessions?

Because the curriculum will be the same for both sessions, we allow students to register for only one session.

Cancellation/Refund Policy:

Each Summer Studio session is limited in size and is filled on a first-come, first-serve basis. Cancellations will be honored and a full refund issued if made by the May 15 deadline. No refunds are granted to students who are dismissed while the studio is in session.

Wait List:

A wait list will be established when all spaces in a Summer Studio session are filled. The wait list for each session will be no more than 10 students. If you are placed on a wait list your application will be kept on file and your deposit check will be voided with notification of your wait list status. If a space opens up wait listed applicants will be contacted via phone and email according to their placement on the list. If the student chooses to accept the available spot, the full studio tuition is due immediately.
