

Workshop: Learn to Knit with Katherine Diuguid

Workshop for ages 14+ (Open to eighth graders, high school students, college students and adults)

February 25, 2012 • 10 a.m.–12:30 p.m.

Have you always wanted to learn to knit? This workshop is for you!

Designed for the beginner, in this workshop you will learn casting on, knitting, purling and binding off. Each participant will start a simple scarf, and receive a set of needles to take home with them.

Katherine Diuguid is an artist/designer and teacher. She recently graduated with her Master of Art and Design from NC State University concentrating in Fibers and Textiles. She also earned a Bachelor of Industrial Design from North Carolina State University and an Associate of Applied Science in Fashion Design from Parsons in New York. She currently teaches in the Department of Art + Design at NC State University. She continues her exploration of hand dressmaking and metal thread hand embroidery history and technique as well as learning new embroidery techniques.

FEES + MATERIALS

The workshop costs \$30 per student (checks to “NC State University” should be submitted with registration forms). This fee includes all materials.

LOCATION + PARKING

CAM Raleigh is located at 409 West Martin Street, between Harrington and West streets.
