



CAM RALEIGH SCHOOL/ YOUTH GROUP VISIT REQUESTS

We do our best to accommodate all requests, but please note that submitting a request does not guarantee your request is granted. In order to receive free or reduced admission for your group, we do require **a minimum of 14 days advance notice for all school and youth group visit requests**. You will receive a confirmation via email once availability is determined. Please print out and bring a copy of your confirmation email with you on the day of your visit.

Choose a Type of Tour

*Most tours, either guided or self-guided, may be completed in an hour.

Guided Tours are led by museum staff or trained volunteers who will apply an interactive approach to understand and engage with the works on view.

Self-Guided Visits are available to groups of students high school age or older. A CAM Raleigh staff member will provide a brief orientation to the exhibitions upon the group's arrival.

Preview Our Current Exhibitions

CAM Raleigh is a non-collecting museum of contemporary art and design. Our exhibitions rotate in and out of our galleries every 3-4 months. Please check our exhibition listings online in advance of scheduling your tour to see what will be on view on your desired tour date. As a museum dedicated to the art and design of our time, CAM Raleigh exhibitions will feature thought provoking work. From time to time, these works will explore challenging subject matter.

If you live in the Triangle area you may want to preview exhibitions by attending one of our Teacher Lounge Exhibition Previews offered prior to every exhibition opening. More information on these events are listed within the Teachers section of our website under Programming.

Directions & Parking

CAM Raleigh is located at 409 W Martin Street in downtown Raleigh, between Harrington and West Streets. Limited parking is available in our adjacent lot on the west side of the building. Metered and hourly street parking is also available. Buses may drop off groups directly in the loading zone along W Martin Street and then proceed to park. Please let us know if additional bus parking information will be needed for your group.

Review the Group Guidelines and Procedures:

In order to ensure that you receive the best possible museum experience, please review the following guidelines and procedures and share them with your group prior to your arrival.

1. Considerate behavior is expected of all visitors. Group leaders are responsible for the behavior of their group at all times.
2. Any group or individual whose behavior is disruptive may be asked to leave.
3. No shouting, running or unruly conduct.
4. All visitors must comply with the directions of CAM Raleigh personnel particularly: Gallery Attendants, Museum Tour Guides and Museum Educators.
5. One (1) adult chaperone for every 5 students is required of all student groups grades K-8. For high school groups we require one (1) adult chaperone for every 10 students. Chaperones must monitor their students at all times.
6. No food or drink of any kind is allowed in the galleries.
7. Large bags, backpacks and umbrellas must be left with the lobby attendants.
8. Please silence all cell phones while on a tour.
9. Photography is permitted only for personal use: some restrictions may apply – please ask your tour guide upon arrival for photography policy in the current exhibition(s).
10. Please be aware of your surroundings. Artworks may be underfoot, overhead, in motion and all around.
11. Please keep a safe distance from artworks (a couple of feet is a good rule of thumb if no taped lines are present).
12. Assume you cannot touch the artwork unless a Gallery Attendant or signage indicates that touching is ok.

Upon arrival:

Check in at the admission desk:

Please plan to arrive a few minutes early to allow time to check in, visit the restroom and collect oversized bags to leave at the front desk. The Group Leader must check in at the admissions desk and present their confirmation email. The Visitor Services representative will have your booking information on hand and be able to answer any questions you may have. The admissions desk will alert the Museum Educator or Guide assigned to your group of your arrival and provide museum admissions signifiers for your group.
